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1. Introduction

This document presents a quick guide to the web application.

It provides a quick 'how to' guide and explains the symbols used within system. In addition, it showcases a surgery form.

2. Browser

We recommend using a recent version of the Google Chrome or the Firefox browser have the best user experience. Other and older browsers might not support all features of the web application.

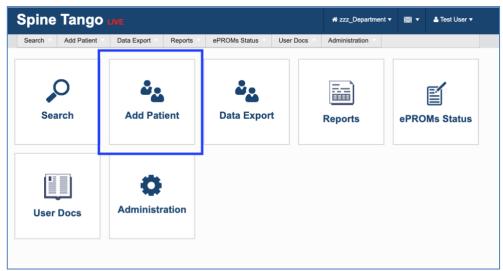




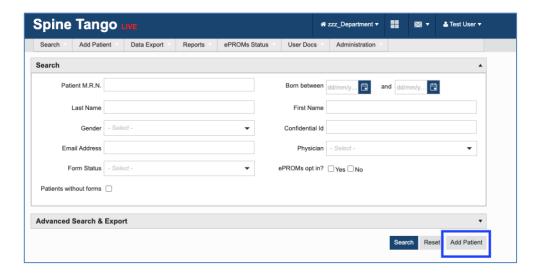
3. Add patients and forms

a. Add patient

To add a new patient, click on "Add Patient" via the Dashboard or in the menu on the top bar.



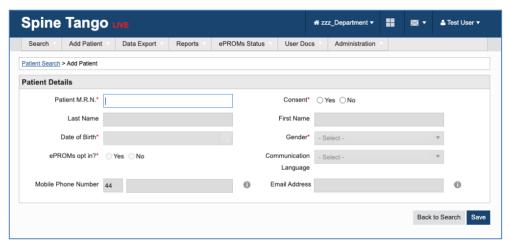
You can also add a patient by clicking on the button "add a patient at the bottom of the "Search" page.





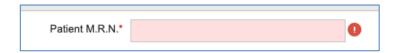


The "add a patient" screen looks like this:



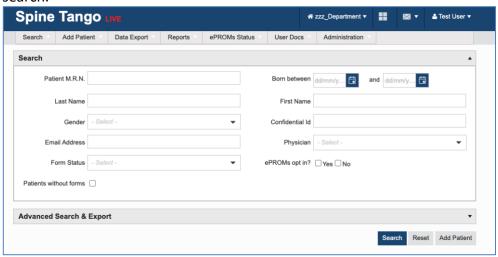
Fields marked with a red star * are mandatory.

If a mandatory field left empty, the registry application will highlight the empty mandatory field like in the below example to signalise missed but required data entry:



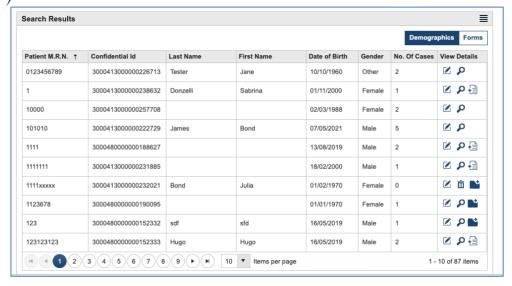
b. Add a new clinical case or a form

To add a new case or a form to an existing patient, search for and find the patient using the search.



Select the record from the search results.





For a new patient with no existing forms, click on "Add Case" from the search results

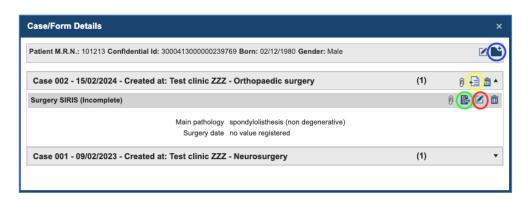
To add a new case, select "Add Case" (circle

(circled in blue).

To add a new form, select "Add Form" (circled in yellow)

To edit an existing form, select (circled in red).

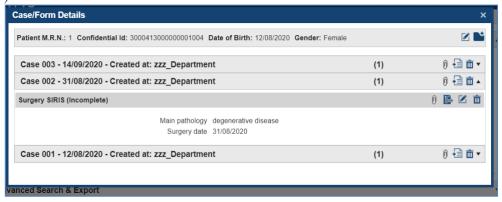
To move a form, select [6] (circled in green)



To edit an existing form, select edit If from the search results or from within a selected case.







c. Forms

All forms work in a similar way. The items for selection are usually available from a drop-down list. The selected items are recorded against the form being completed <u>once saved</u>. A form does not have to be completed before it can be saved. Once a form has been completed, it should be <u>submitted</u>. Only submitted forms are used for reporting.

Depending on the registry, you may see a variety of forms which can be added (Spine Tango) or only two surgery forms (SIRIS Spine).

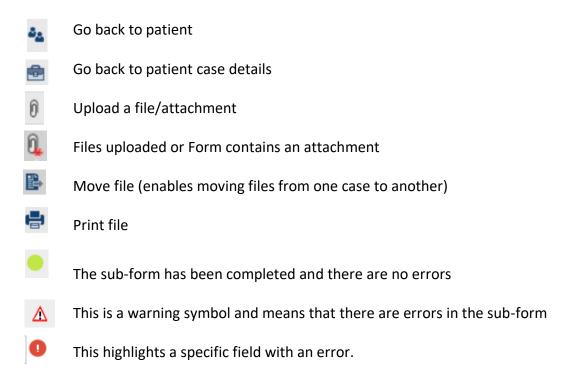

d. Main Symbols used in a form

The following symbols are the main symbols used in the system. All symbols contain help text. When hovered over, an explanation of what the symbol stands for is provided.



This is a single select field. You can only select one option



This is a multi-select field. Multi-selections are denoted by square boxes. Where these appear, more than one selection is possible.





4. Surgery form (Example)

The specific variables are presented under the relevant sub-forms, which may vary depending on the form type and form version. The current example of the surgery form below has Admission/Pathology, Surgery, Surgical Measures and Hospital Stay sub-forms.

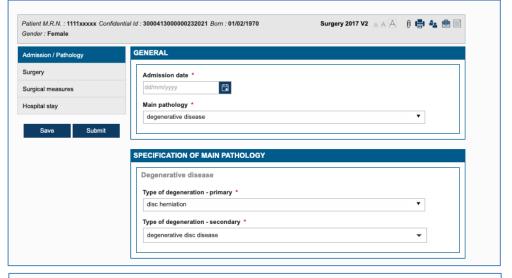


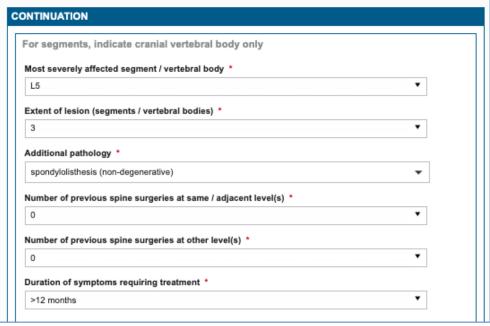
e. Admission/Pathology sub-form

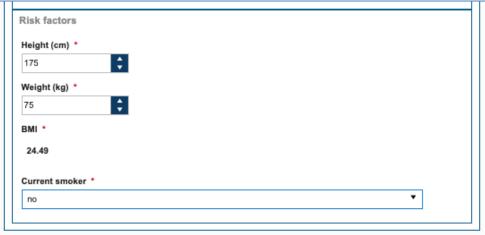
This sub-form covers the entry of all the main pathology. On selecting a main pathology, the specification of main pathology section is limited to the main pathology selected. The screen shot below shows an example for a main pathology of 'Degenerative disease'. The specification of any further details is limited to the relevant information required for 'Degenerative disease'.









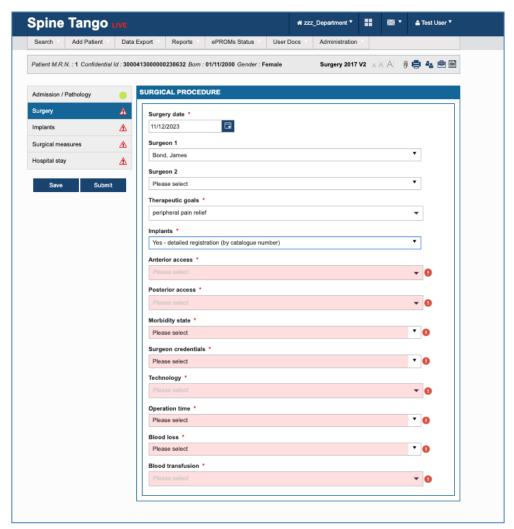






f. Surgery sub-form

The surgery sub form contains information about surgery. Surgical measures are to be specified in the next sub-form.

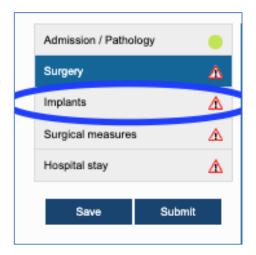


g. Implant sub-form

An implant sub-form will appear if the question on implants will be answered with yes.

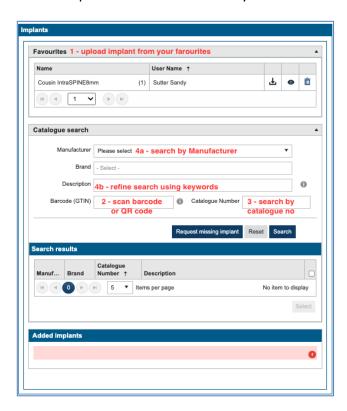

Below are several options for how an implant can be registered, ordered by simplicity:

- 1. by loading the implant (or group of implants) from your favourite list, if it was already saved as a favourite before,
- 2. by clicking into the "Barcode (GTIN)" field and scanning the barcode or QR-code,
- 3. (if no implant barcode or QR-code is available) by entering the article/catalogue number into the field "Catalogue Number" and searching and adding the found implant,
- 4. (if no barcode or QR-code and no article number are available) by selecting the manufacturer and then searching by keywords. If you use multiple keywords, please separate them with a star symbol *.







h. Surgical measures sub-form

This screen shots below show the required information for the surgical measures section.

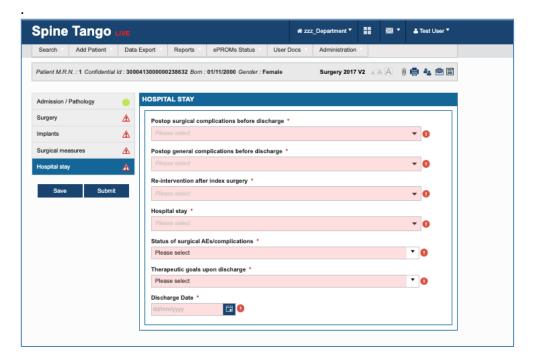






i. Hospital stay sub-form

Below is a screenshot of the hospital stay sub-form, which may be available depending on the surgery form version.



Once all questions have been answered and any errors corrected, the warning symbols change to a green circle and the form can be saved and submitted.
